OUI Inc.'s Smart Eye Camera expands to Mozambique!

In September 2022, Shintaro Nakayama from OUI Inc. visited Mozambique to pilot our Smart Eye Camera!



First, we visited Lurio University in Nampula Province. In Lurio University, there is a faculty of optometry, which was founded as the first optometry course in Mozambique. Now there are about 120 students studying Optometry in Lurio.

Since there are only a few ophthalmologists based in the entire province of Nampula, the optometrists are expected to have an important role to improve eye care of the residents in the province.

In this pilot, we started community eye-screening with the optometrists/students in the local community, using our Smart Eye Camera. In the community of Muatala, a 20-minute drive from Lurio, we visited each household and conducted eye screening for the residents in the community. We piloted the telemedicine using Smart Eye Camera; we observed the eyes of the community residents with Smart Eye Camera, uploaded the data in the cloud, and the ophthalmologists in Japan provided the result of the diagnosis through software.

During our stay, we could observe more than 200 residents and we could have a very positive perspective. We will keep proceeding with the community screening, aiming to compile the output in research paper, and publish it in some medical conference as a joint research collaboration between Lurio University and OUI Inc.!

We also visited Hospital Central de Maputo in Maputo and Dr. Agarwals Eye Hospital, capital city of Mozambique. We introduced our Smart Eye Camera to the ophthalmologists in these hospitals, exchanged opinions and explored possibilities for future collaboration. This allowed us to see a very positive outlook for our future collaboration with ophthalmologists in Mozambique!
